## SAINT PAUL CATHOLIC HIGH SCHOOL COURSE SELECTION PROCESS

### REGISTER AND PAY ONLINE

FOLLOW THESE STEPS TO SELECT COURSES:

1. Go to: [www.niagaracatholic.ca](http://www.niagaracatholic.ca)
2. Select **STUDENTS** (top bar of screen)
3. Select **NCVLE**
4. Choose **STUDENT LOGIN** and login using Niagara Catholic credentials
5. Go to **DIGITAL TOOLS** and then select **MYBLUEPRINT**
6. From the dashboard, click on **PLAN COURSES**
7. Add courses to your High School Plan by clicking on **+ Course** for each subject
8. Click on **Review Course Selections** to review your chosen courses
9. Click **Submit Course Selections** to submit courses
10. **Pay \$55 Activity fee** and complete parent declaration on Schoolcash online

To ensure the best chance of getting the courses you select, it is important that you use the following general guidelines:

- ✓ **Students that will be in grade 10 and 11 must choose 8 credits**
- ✓ **Students that will be in Grade 12 must choose at least 7 credits**
- ✓ When selecting your courses make sure you are fulfilling ALL your diploma requirements
- ✓ When selecting your courses you must have the prerequisite for each course
- ✓ **Failed Compulsory credits must be achieved first** (Summer School Applications open in Spring).

#### **FOR GRADE 10 STUDENTS:**

- ✓ Select **one** Religion Course: HRE2O or HRE2OF (for students selecting FEF2D or FIF2D)
- ✓ Select Career Studies & Civics: CHV2O + GLC2O-0.5 credits each (even if taking at summer school)
- ✓ Select **one** English Course: ENG2D (Academic), ENG2DA (AP Prep), ENG2P (Applied), ENG2L (Locally Developed)
- ✓ Select **one** Math Course: MPM2D (Academic), MPM2DA (AP Prep), MFM2P (Applied), MAT2L (Locally Developed)
- ✓ Select **one** Science Course: SNC2D (Academic), SNC2DA (AP Prep), SNC2P (Applied), SVN3E (Workplace)
- ✓ Select **one** History Course: CHC2D (Academic), CHC2DA (AP Prep), CHC2P (Applied), CHC2L (Locally Developed) \*\* GRADE 10 FI students must select CGC1DF (Geographie en Francais)
- ✓ **Select TWO ELECTIVES**

#### **FOR GRADE 11 STUDENTS:**

- ✓ Select **one** Religion Course: HRT3M or HRT3MF (for students selecting FEF3U or FIF3U)
- ✓ Select **one** English Course: NBE3U (University) or NBE3C (College) or ENG3E (Workplace)  
\*\*ENG3U/3C are offered in e-learning format only
- ✓ Select **one** Math Course: MCR3U (University), MCF3M (Mixed- prerequisite for MCT4C, MDM4U and MAP4C), MBF3C (College-prerequisite for MAP4C), MEL3E (Workplace)
- ✓ **Select FIVE ELECTIVES**  
(These options should prepare you for your Post-Secondary Destination)

#### **FOR GRADE 12 STUDENTS:**

- ✓ Select **one** Religion Course: HRE4M (recommended for students selecting ENG4U), HRE4MF (for students selecting FEF4U), HRE4O (recommended for students selecting ENG4C)
- ✓ Select **one** English Course: ENG4U (University), ENG4C (College) or ENG4E (Workplace)
- ✓ **Select FIVE or SIX ELECTIVES**  
(It is essential that that you satisfy the Ontario Secondary School Diploma Requirements and the Entrance Requirements of your Post-Secondary Destination)

**\*\*Please note that students must complete 2 credits through elearning as part of the Ministry of Education graduation requirements or must opt out of the requirement prior to graduation.**

*Students entering into Grade 11 and 12 are reminded to research post-secondary programs before choosing their courses to ensure that prerequisites are met.*

*Appointments with Guidance are also recommended.*
